British homes are usually small. Old people, young families and unmarried people do
not usually live together. Many English people love old houses, and these are often more
expensive than modern ones. They also love gardening, and you will see gardens everywhere
you go: in towns, villages and in the country. Some are very small, with just one
tree and a few flowers. Others are enormous, with **plenty of** flowers and enough vegetables
and fruit trees to feed a family.

There are 22 million homes in Britain – big homes and small homes, old cottages and new high-rise buildings, houses and flats.

Two thirds of the families in Britain own their own homes. Millions of these "owner-occupied" houses are the same, with two or three bedrooms and a bathroom upstairs, a sitting room, a dining room and a kitchen downstairs and a small garden at the back and front of the house. To pay for their house, home owners **borrow** money from a "building society" and pay back a little every month.

One quarter of British people live in rented state-owned homes, called "council houses". Many of these are flats, but some are houses, each with a small piece of garden. Other people rent their homes from private owners.

There are many different kinds of homes in Britain, but there are not enough! It is often very difficult for young people to find a home when they want to start a family.
